

New Integrative Medicine Elective Available!

The Advocate Medical Group Center for Complementary Medicine is now offering an elective in integrative medicine for 3rd and 4th year medical students. Our medical student rotation can be adjusted to the needs of the student and can be either 2 or 4 weeks long. The rotation will include an extensive lecture curriculum coupled with actual on-site observation of complementary medicine therapies, including:

- The Integrative Medicine Evaluation
- Herb/Supplement Pharmacology
- Mind-Body Medicine
- Massage/Therapeutic Bodywork
- Acupuncture
- Chiropractic
- Homeopathy
- Natural Nutrition
- Yoga Therapy
- Aromatherapy

The rotation also includes participation in our weekly integrative medicine case conferences as well as discussion time with our practitioners. Availability of on-site experiences will vary with practitioners' schedules.
